## **Agenda Items:**

#### 1. Principal's Report (Lisa Clayton)

- School wide focus areas
  - Listening with attention and intention Model behaviour so that children listen to each other
  - Renewed literacy focus phonological awareness for younger grades, comprehension for older grades

- New Math Curriculum Scope and Sequence document has been provided by board staff. Curriculum change example– no longer learn about money, instead about financial literacy (debit cards, PayPal, etc)
- Third Path Webinar Series The premise is that achievement and well-being are intermingled for success. 10-12 teachers are working together on it and discussing the material at coffee chats.
- Recess Equipment Children are allowed to bring items from home, currently at the discretion of the teachers.
- Gym has been cleared of excess furniture that had been removed from classrooms to allow 1 meter spacing of students. All items were reviewed; some items went to Surplus Furniture and the items that were kept are now on the stage. The gym is open for students starting today. Starting slow.
- Rapid Antigen Tests are coming. The Ministry is planning to send approximately 5 tests home with each student over Christmas. Optional. More information coming.
- Spirit Wear options were shared with teachers.
- Acceptable Use of Technology Policy Review - https://ocdsb.ca/cms/one.aspx?portalId=55478&pageId=37059829
  - The current policy is from 2012 and doesn't mention new technologies (e.g. Social Media)
  - The Grade 4-6 Appropriate Use of Technology Agreement and Policy (P.100.IT) was reviewed quickly.
  - Lisa Clayton addresses issues with use of technology as they happen/she becomes aware.
  - School devices should only be used for educational purposes not social media, games, etc.
  - o Feedback
    - The policy needs updated language.
    - Kindergarten to grade 3 is a big age range and use of technology by children in this age range varies. Kinders have limited access to technology. Maybe the Kinders should have a separate Appropriate Use of Technology Agreement.
    - Media Permission needs to be clearer.
    - Policy should cover BYOD.
  - Donna Send link to Policy review out via email. Lisa Clayton has agreed to collect feedback since the official deadline has passed.
